

Automatic timeout

The Administration page allows health centers to set the automatic log-off for inactive users. By automatically logging the user out after a predefined period of inactivity, the application reduces the risk of someone else gaining access to the user's account or data within the application. The Saber Analytics default setting is 15 minutes.

To set the automatic timeout:

1. Navigate to the **Admin settings**.
2. In the left-hand menu, Click **About Us** and then Click **Automatic timeout**.
3. Enter the desired number of minutes in the textbox.

Note: Enter a number between 1 and 60.

4. Click **Save**.

Automatic timeout See history

The purpose of an automatic time out is for security reasons. It helps prevent unauthorized access to sensitive information if a user forgets to log out or leaves their session unattended. By automatically logging the user out after a predefined period of inactivity (such as 15 minutes or 30 minutes), the application reduces the risk of someone else gaining access to the user's account or data within the application.
