

Value sets

The Value sets page displays the standardized values from the value set authority for the electronic Clinical Quality Measures (eCQMs). These values are universal and not unique to your health center's clinical workflows.

Important Note: Not every eCQM applies to every health center. Some value sets may be deactivated for your health center to ensure users only view the value sets relevant to your health center's reporting needs.

The **Value sets** page displays the following:

- **Measure ID:** This refers to the identifier for the eCQM.
- **Measure Title:** This is the full name of the eCQM.
- **Value set name:** This refers to the group of medical codes used for a specific purpose.
- **Code system:** This is the standard clinical vocabulary that defines clinical concepts to support effective and interoperable health information exchange.
 - **CPT:** Current Procedural Terminology code set developed by the American Medical Association (AMA).
 - **CVX:** Vaccine administered code set developed and maintained by the CDC's National Center of Immunization and Respiratory Diseases. It includes both active and inactive vaccines.
 - **SOP:** Standard Operating Procedures within healthcare outlines specific protocols and practices to ensure consistent and safe patient care settings.
- **ICD10CM:** International Classification of Diseases, Tenth Revision, Clinical Modification
- **SNOMEDCT:** Also known as SNOMED Clinical Terms, it is a comprehensive multilingual clinical healthcare terminology and a registered trademark of the International Health Terminology Standards Development Organization (IHTSDO).
- **Code:** This is a unique combination of numbers or letters representing a specific medical term or concept.
- **Code description:** This is a brief description of the code's meaning.
- **Clinical focus:** This refers to the main topic or condition that the code or value set addresses.

- **Active:** This refers to whether your health center uses this value set.

To access:

1. Navigate to **Admin settings**.
2. Click the **Value set mappings** in the navigation menu and click **Value sets**.
3. This opens the **Value sets** page.

- The **clinical focus**

Review a specific Value set measure

1. Navigate to **Value set mappings** and click **Value sets**.
2. Click the **Measure drop-down menu** to select the specific measure.

Quick Tip: Click the X to clear the specified Measure and run a new measure search.

3. Or use the **Search by text box** to enter the measure.
4. The list will automatically update the displayed contents based on the criteria entered.

Deactivate a Value set measure

1. Navigate to **Value set mappings** and click **Value sets**.
2. Click the **Measure drop-down menu** to select the specific measure.
3. Or use the **Search by text box** to enter the measure.
4. Locate the specific measure to deactivate.
5. Click the measure's **Active toggle** off.
